

Young Innovator Award (Age 14 - 19)



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The Young Innovator Award is open to nominations for dyslexic young people aged **14 to 19** who are living in the **UK or the Channel Islands**.

We are looking for creative young thinkers who have **invented, designed, improved, or developed something new**. This might be a product, idea, tool, project, or a new way of doing something. Their innovation could be linked to school, college, technology, business, arts, community projects, hobbies, the environment, or anything they are passionate about.

Nominees will be young people who had an idea, or several ideas, and **took action to bring it to life**. They may have created something for themselves, their school, their community, or something that solves a problem for others. What matters most is their creativity, determination, and dyslexic-thinking skills in action.

When nominating, please tell us:

What, why, and how they innovated; what motivated them; the impact their idea or creation has had on you, others, or their community; and what makes them special and deserving of this award. Remember nominees must be **dyslexic and living in the UK or the Channel Islands**.

Eligibility criteria: Dyslexic individuals aged **14-19**, living in the **UK or Channel Islands**.

Who can nominate? Anyone who believes this young innovator deserves recognition.
